- Molino A Vento Fiano Blanc 22, IT 33
A delicious offering from Sicily; fresh & zesty, with tropical fruit, cedar & lemon
- Picpoul de Pinet, Roquemoliere Reserve 23, FR 36
Crisp, light and aromatic, with remarkable freshness. Wonderful with fish or just sipped on its own.
- Glazebrook Sauvignon Blanc 23, NZ 37
Classic Marlborough sauvignon; crisp & refreshing with gooseberry & passion fruit
- Coltrenzio Pinot Grigio 22, IT 39
Classic Italian white with a fruity bouquet; hints of quince, pear & melon
- Grüner Veltliner, Erich Machherndl, 22, AU 39
Bright citron-yellow, apples, pears & gooseberries. Fruit, spice & minerality, with a hint of mint to finish.
- Macon Villages, Terres Secretes, 22, FR 41
Aromas of white flowers, citrus & yellow fruit. Smooth & full in the mouth. Typical of its appellation, it is nicely balanced with real harmony. Great value Burgundy
- Martin Codax Albariño, 22, SP 42
From Riax Baixas, featuring a bouquet of peach, grapefruit & white flowers
- Pouilly Fumé Chateau Favray 23, FR 43
Across the river from Sancerre, Pouilly Fumé wines are very similar in style, with a little more roundness, subtlety & often a touch of smoky minerality from the flintier soil.
- Chardonnay, Thelema, 21, SA 44
An aromatic nose of lime marmalade, guava & melon. Round, packed with tropical fruit. A delicious mineral streak, plus well-integrated oak which lends a creamy texture
- Traditionale Riesling, Pikes, 22, AUS 45
From the Clare Valley, this is a sensational classic dry Riesling. Made from 100% free-run juice. It leaps from the glass with fragrant white floral & kaffir lime character. Full of citrus & lime, it is intense with mouth-watering acidity & a lingering finish
- Fontanafredda Organic Gavi di Gavi 22, IT 49
Aromas of lemon & blossom, with a swirl of green apple, with a long finish
- Domaine de Vauroux Chablis 21, FR 55
Fresh aromas of citrus, small touches of fern or coriander. A typically stony palate layered with white peach & grapefruit
- Péssac-Léognan Blanc, Cru Classé, Chât' Bouscaut, 21, FR 59
This stunning Bordeaux Sauvignon exudes a mélange of aromas: passionfruit, lemon curd, toast, crème brûlée, cinnamon & poached pear. It has a creamy texture, cut across by vibrant acidity. Fabulous length with amazing concentration on the finish
- O Oenólogo Encruzado, Casa da Passarella 21, PO 61
100% hand-harvested Encruzado, an indigenous grape. The fruit starts to ferment on the skins with wild yeasts. After pressing, fermentation continues with one third in new French oak. Aged a further 3 months in barrel. Fresh, bright, citrus aromas with mineral weight, gentle oak & a touch of saline on the finish

Ossian Organic Verdejo, Ossian Vides Y Vinos 77
An extraordinary wine from a unique place, Ossian is the fruit of vines almost 200 years old – rare survivors of the Phylloxera blight. The ancient vines have developed an extensive root system deep within the sand & slate that has protected them for centuries. Juicy-ripe pear fruitiness reminiscent of young white Burgundy, with green fennel, top-quality oak & a grippy mineral' character.

Patz and Hall Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, 2020 90
On the nose, aromas of dried orange peel, roasted almond, lemon sugar cookie and green apple are nicely supported by spicy French oak. Crisp and juicy with a cascading, mouthwatering finish.

Riesling Frédéric Emile, Trimbach, 17, Alsace 99
Deep enticing aromas of candied lemons, lime marmalade, quince, pineapple, chamomile & honey. Fabulously satisfying, rich texture in the mouth is kept fresh by zesty acidity & enlivened by intriguing notes of beeswax, pine forest, pineapple & lemon. The wealth of fruit creates an impression of sweetness, yet it is, in truth, pretty much bone dry.

Puligny-Montrachet Maison Roche de Bellene, 21, FR 150
Displaying attractive peach, marzipan & struck flint notes, the concentration from older vines & the intensity of the vintage are evident on the palate. The wine has both appealing vibrancy and satisfying richness. Beautiful white Burgundy at its best.

Meursault Les Grands Charrons, M Bouzereau, 20, FR 150
From one of Meursault's most distinguished growers. Grands Charrons sits at the same height as the Meursault Premier Crus but with a more easterly exposure. This wine is beautifully aromatic with a bouquet of toasted hazelnuts, orange blossom & butterscotch. The palate offers up flavours of white fruits with a sublime honeyed richness & hint of toasted oak.

Aubert & Mathieu Palooza Rosé 22, FR 35
A pale Grenache-Syrah blend from Languedoc-Roussillon, by a pair of young winemakers who specialise in terroir-focused wines. Notes of Morello cherries, raspberries, & nectarine.

Sauska Rosé 22, HU 36
A dry, pale pink Hungarian rosé made with the native Kékfrankos grape (known as Blaufränkisch elsewhere) Hibiscus, forest berries & pear aromas. Flavours of pomegranate, raspberries, & tart cherries. A wine with both flavour & elegance

Château Léoube Provence Rosé 22, FR 45
The signature organic rosé from Léoube on the Côte d'Azur. Hand tended grapes, artisanal techniques & biodynamic principles make this pale pink Provence something seriously special. Perfect for a Summer's day!

Maison Sainte-Marguerite Symphonie 22, FR 55
This stunner from Château Sainte Marguerite is one of the ultimate expressions of Provence rosé. Finesse, elegance and aromatic pleasure - it is clear and bright with a light pink hue. On the nose, it's floral and delicate with aromas of white flowers & passion fruit. On the palate, delicate acidity with notes of peach, orange peel & exotic fruits
